We are offering Algebra I on Mondays and Wednesdays, from 3:15 to 4:30p.m. in order to prepare you to take the New York State Algebra I Regents in June 2012. In order to take those Regents, you must take this after school course and **pass** your 8th grade math course each trimester.

There is no cost for this course. There is no cost to take the Regents exam. If you commit to take the Regents exam and then change your mind, you pay the cost of the Regents exam (because the school is then billed for the exam that wasn't taken.)
